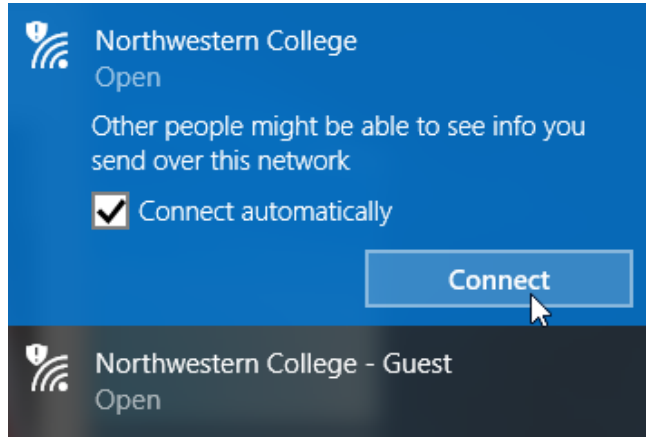
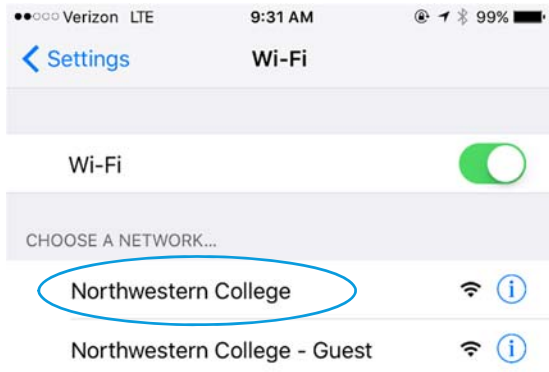


CONNECTING TO WIFI

HOW TO CONNECT YOUR WIRELESS DEVICE TO THE INTERNET

1. Open the Wi-Fi section of your device and locate the network called “**Northwestern College.**”
2. Tap or click to connect.



If you are on a mobile device, the login page may automatically appear. Or, it might prompt you to open a browser and log in. Type in your username and password, read the Acceptable Use Policy and click “login”.

Note: *The login button won't light up until you scroll to the bottom of the agreement*
